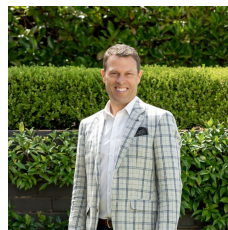

Built-in 1890, this residence bears witness to the vibrant history of Kensington Village. Remnants of the original stables, once bustling with horses serving the famous Adelaide and Suburban Tramway Co. connection between Kensington and the city, confirm the home's rich heritage.

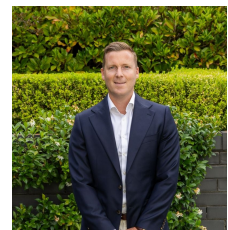
Sitting behind the original wrought iron fence, crafted by local blacksmiths, the home's exemplary examples of Victorian architecture are on display. Intricate lacework adorns the eyelash-front verandah, intricate cast moldings around the windows, and stunning bluestone walls down the sides of the home confirm the home's status as a landmark property.

Beautifully preserved, extended, and modernised over the years, the home will appeal to families. Its generous and deep (64m) allotment showcases an in-ground pool and

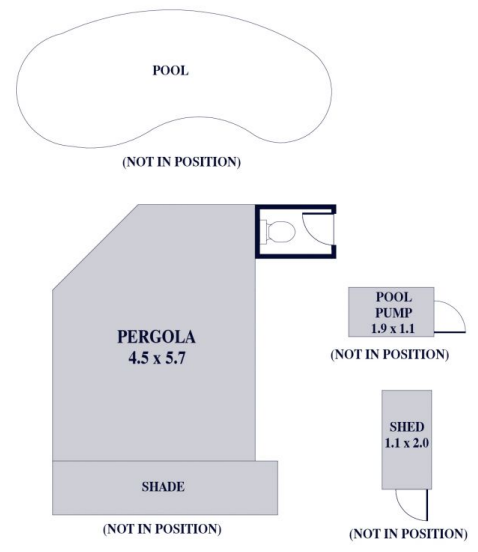
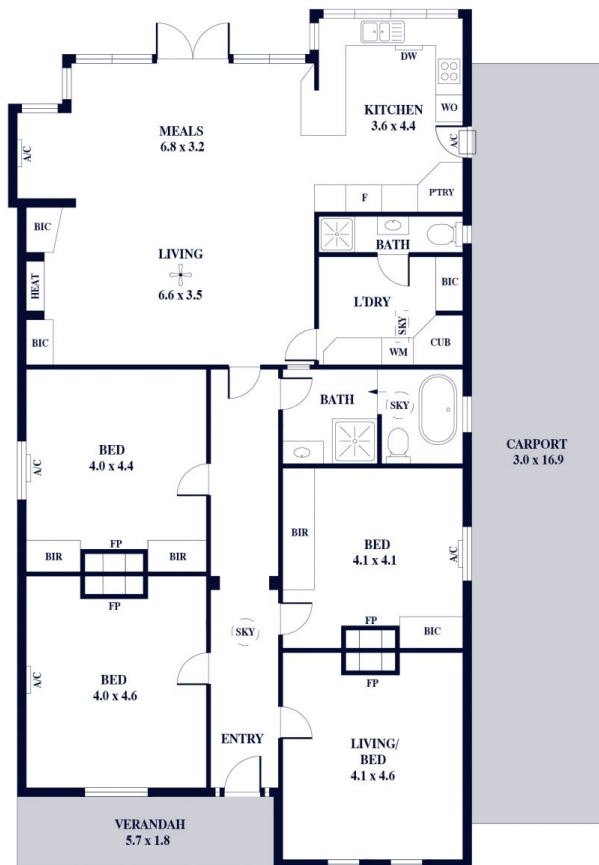
